### **Course Outline**

In Advanced Higher Business Management pupils study 3 units:

- The Internal Business Environment
- The External Business Environment
- Evaluating Business Information

Pupils are also required to research a business topic and apply the findings of the research to an organisation, organisations or industry in order to produce a coherent report. They will use skills of independent working, planning, research, use of sources, analysis and evaluation during this process. The completed report should be between 2,500-3,500 words, excluding footnotes, bibliography and appendices.

As the Advanced Higher Business Management course is designed to prepare pupils for university it is expected that pupils will dedicate a significant amount of their study periods in school and time at home to carrying out independent research. This will allow classes to adopt a more tutorial based format where pupils discuss and debate the research and reading that they have carried out.

# **Exam Preparation**

As the Advanced Higher Business Management exam approaches, pupils should carry out as much timed practice of Case Studies and extended response questions as possible. Pupils should make regular use of business news sources to further develop their understanding and level of detail in their answers. Pupils should regularly review their notes from class and access a range of materials to help develop their understanding of the content covered. These materials are made available to pupils at the beginning of the course. The exam is 2 hours 45 minutes in length. Pupils should be spending no more than 1 hour 30 minutes of that time on the Case Study section, giving 1 hour 15 minutes to the extended response questions. These times should be used as a guide when practising past paper questions. Pupils will also have the opportunity to carry out exam practice in class.









#### **Useful Websites**

Advanced Higher Business Management candidates should use a wide range of websites to help them prepare and develop throughout the course.

For course content pupils should make use of webistes such as: Scholar, Tutor2u

One of the most valuable way to enhance their knowledge is to regularly research relevant issues that are currently in the news. Thus websites such as: The BBC, Financial Times, Guardian, Telegraph, Independent, Scotsman or any other quality newspaper will be of great use.

Watching television programmes such as Question Time, Newsnight, Sunday Politics, Dragons' Den and the Apprenticeship will also greatly help their understanding of key issues in Business Management.


## **Useful Textbooks**
