Course Outline

In National 3/4 RMPS candidates will study three main topic areas.

Morality and Belief:

- Religion and Relationships (S4)
- Religion and Justice (S5&6)

World Religions:

- Islam (S4)
- Buddhism (S5&6)

Religious and Philosophical Questions:

• Existence of God (S4,5&6)

At National 3 and 4 levels there is no SQA examination. Pupils must complete unit assessments on each of the above units. Pupils will also complete a research assignment (the Added Value Unit) and report which will be judged on a pass or fail basis. All units must be completed before the end of the course if the SQA are to issue the qualification

National 5 candidates should aim to carry out regular independent research throughout the year in keeping with the topic they are studying.

Added Value Unit

As part of the course outcomes, pupils sitting National 4 are required to complete an Added Value Unit. This unit consists of a research task and should comment on a religious, moral or philosophical issue in the world today. Pupils must choose a topic area and carry out research from a variety of sources. Pupils must also present their research and come to a decision or conclusion about the issue.

National 3/4 RMPS candidates should use a wide range of websites to help them prepare and develop throughout the course. One of the most valuable ways to enhance their knowledge is to regularly research any relevant issues that are in the news.
