At Meadowpark we follow the Broad General Education (BGE) based on East Lothian's Curriculum Frameworks S1 –S3. In S4 young people are supported into the Senior Phase where they will receive qualifications based on what they can do: Nat 2- Nat 5.

We work closely with Skills Development Scotland (SDS), Edinburgh College, Outdoor Learning, Aubigny Sports Centre and the local community.
