


PUPILS MUST HAVE 1, 2 AND EITHER 3 OR 4





- Shown a high level of endeavor and commitment to the activity (+18 months), and where appropriate performed at a high level
- 2. Attended more than 80% of the available activity sessions (unless appropriate reason offered)
- 3. Where appropriate, performed to a high level while representing the school in more than 75% of available events, competitions or fixtures or shown a high level of commitment to an out of school activity such as volunteering/coaching
- 4. Where there is limited or no opportunity for competition, but a pupil shows significant commitment to a progress, the Achievement Tie Committee may give consideration to this

RE-AWARD CERTIFICATE
CRITERIA



PUPILS MUST HAVE:

Fulfilled the criteria for an Achievement Tie

One further year after receiving the initial Achievement Tie



ENDEAVOUR CERTIFICATE CRITERIA



Where a pupil has achieved Criteria 1 and 2 but there has been no opportunity for competition (Criteria 3) or participation at the required level

- 1. Shown a high level of endeavor and commitment to the activity (+18 months), and where appropriate performed at a high level
 - 2. Attended more than 80% of the available activity sessions (unless appropriate reason offered)

The Achievement Tie Committee may award an Endeavour Certificate



NON SCHOOL-BASED ACTIVITIES REGIONAL/NATIONAL AWARD OR REPRESENTATION (FULL COLOURS ACHIEVEMENT TIE)

PUPILS MUST HAVE:




1. Where the opportunity arises, performed at a high level at regional and/or national level/competition



2. Made a significant impact in, or through, the chosen activity at a community, regional or national level, as decided by the committee

RE-AWARD CERTIFICATE CRITERIA



PUPILS MUST HAVE:

Fulfilled the criteria for an Achievement Tie

One further year after receiving the initial Achievement Tie



ENDEAVOUR CERTIFICATE



It is not possible for the school to make an objective judgement on this type of award

so there can be no award at this level within this category

CIRCUMSTANCES



The Achievement Tie Committee may consider an 'other' achievement that is not covered by the criteria. This will be at the discretion of the committee



REMOVAL OF AWARD



While this would not be pleasant in the event that any pupil who displays poor conduct within the school or the local community that would be considered to reflect badly on the school then awards may be removed
