## About Me!



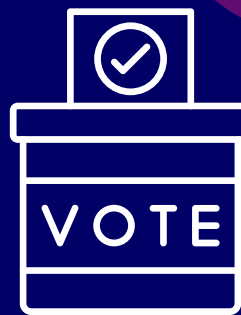

## Policy 1: Study Areas

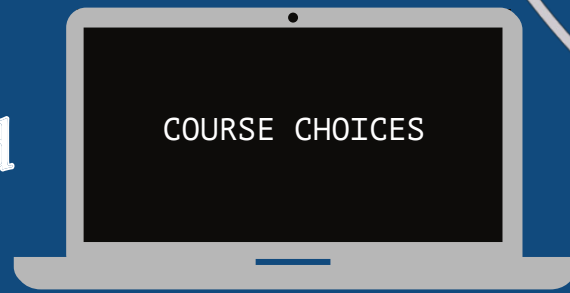


## Policy 2: Strengthen our community

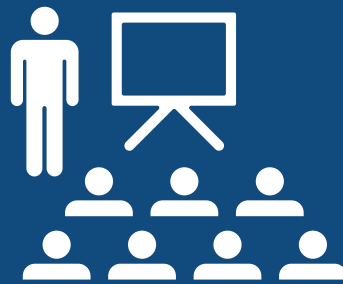


## Policy 3: Coursing Information and Taster Lessons



Choosing a subject sounds easy but it is one of the most difficult decisions we have to make, especially when you know nothing about that subject. I would like to change this so that every week on the lead up to course choices (after the Christmas holidays) faculties will pick students to come together and produce a small project that would be shown to other students who are keen to take that subject, but are unsure what it is about. Senior pupils could inform any year, but particularly those who are choosing paths for their future. I would also like to implement taster lessons which could be scheduled during lunch time or after school so that pupils could get a feel for that subject. This would prevent pupils from dropping out of subjects later in the year as they aren't enjoying the course, or this will encourage pupils to move out of their comfort zone and try something new. This could be led by a teacher or Seniors.

## Policy 4: Club Awareness

This could be done through assemblies or videos posted on the bulletin. This will allow new S1's or anyone in the school the opportunity to join the clubs that are in their interest.
