detail of those criteria was as follows: · have had their
second COVID-19 vaccination more than 14 days ago
have a valid vaccination record (You can download the
NHS Scotland Covid Status app or get a paper record of
your vaccine status from NHS Inform.) · not have symptoms
of COVID-19 · have evidence of a negative PCR test · take
daily lateral flow tests for up to 10 days after being exposed
to the virus · fully comply with any PPE requirements, hand
hygiene and other infection control measures 90. Staff who
cannot reasonably isolate from on-going exposure to a
COVID-19 positive household member should not volunteer
to return to work.
