Why are they so important?


- Becoming familiar with the style of questions

How to Use them


- Focus on weaker areas

- Hand them in for teacher feedback
- Don't try to do too much too soon e.g. sections you haven't covered yet!
- Look at the marking guides but with a hint of caution – they are written for the markers.
