Equity

School uniforms reduce economic and social barriers between young people. Uniforms are usually cheaper than other clothing.
Uniform prevents pupils feeling pressured to wear certain types of clothing.

Safety

School uniforms can increase pupil safety. Uniforms make pupils easily identifiable and helps to spot anyone who should not be in the school. This is also the reason we ask no hooded tops to be worn, as hoods can be worn up, we don't know who the person is and this compromises the safety of all.

Speed
