



How to study Maths

Use Past Papers Wisely:

Make a list of your mistakes
Write out solutions, don't just read them
If you don't understand a question, ask for help!
Go back a few days later and do the questions on your mistake list again.
If you get it wrong again, keep it on the mistakes list, ask about it, and try it again a few days later.

Have you been using your Green Sheet to help you know what to revise?

NEVER: just read your notes.
Maths is a practical subject.
You need to do questions!

BE STRATEGIC: sometimes do whole past papers, sometimes do focus on one topic.
e.g. have a day where you do all of the tricky circle questions.
Focus on your weaknesses!

Take advantage of the help offered:
Supported study/ Easter revision, etc.
Higher Maths Camp
Lunchtime/ Before School

TEST YOURSELF:
Do past papers without your notes
See what you really know
Redo the paper a few weeks later
Have you improved?

Use weekly quizzes:
To focus your study
Reattempt what you get wrong
Ask for help
Do a textbook exercise on that topic.
